

# Voucher Contracts

Licensed child care providers in the Boston Area can enter into a voucher contract with CCCB.

What is a voucher contract?

Voucher contracts enable family day cares, centers and systems to accept and be reimbursed for enrolling voucher children. (Family day care providers enrolled with systems have a voucher contract with the system and, therefore, can not contract with a resource and referral agency directly)

How to set up a voucher contract...

Providers first must register for and attend a Voucher Training. At the course, they will learn about the voucher system and the requirements of becoming a voucher provider. After completing the workshop and submitting all necessary paperwork, the provider will be notified when they can begin to enroll children with a voucher.

Voucher Rates and Reimbursement

Providers are reimbursed at the end of the following month in which care is provided. Reimbursement rates are based on the provider's private rates and tier documentation completed. Voucher rates may not exceed the cap established by the Department of Early Education and Care. Family day care systems and centers may request reimbursement for transportation as part of their contract.
